Fund Strategy ■

This actively managed exchange traded fund seeks to achieve its objective primarily through investment in U.S. companies with market capitalizations similar to the market capitalization of the companies in the Russell 1000® Value Index at the time of investment.

Investment Style ■

The Fund's value style emphasizes securities that the sub-advisors believe: have below-average projected price to earnings or price to cash flow ratios, exhibit below-average price to book value ratios, generate above-average dividend yields, and have above-average return on equity or earnings growth potential.

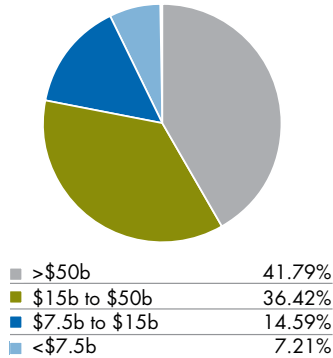

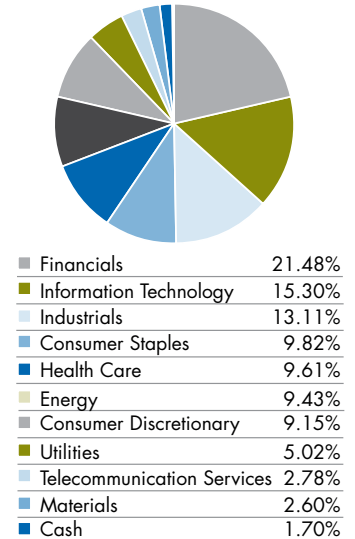
Market Capitalization ■

Hotchkis and Wiley strives to exploit these opportunities by employing disciplined purchase and sell criteria, rigorous in-house fundamental research and a bottom-up stock selection process with emphasis on tangible valuation support.

Metropolitan West Capital Management, LLC, Newport Beach, California, identifies the stocks of high-quality, growing businesses that are selling at a discount to their "intrinsic" or true value. MetWest Capital's investment professionals examine each company from top to bottom, as if they were buying the whole firm. They look beyond the balance sheet and income statement for hidden assets. They focus only on high-quality businesses that have financial strength, capable, proven and properly motivated managements and improving business fundamentals.

Hotchkis and Wiley

- Market Cap: Greater than \$1 billion
- Earnings yield (earnings/price)
- Payout yield (dividends plus stock buybacks)
- Financial strength

Metropolitan West

- Market Cap: Typically greater than \$2 billion
- High-quality businesses in each economic sector
- Focus on qualitative as well as quantitative measures

Definitions

P/E Ratio: A valuation ratio of a company's current share price compared to its per-share earnings. The P/E ratio of the fund is calculated as the weighted average of the P/E ratios of all the stocks in the fund's portfolio. Stocks with negative P/E ratios are excluded from this calculation.

P/B Ratio: A ratio used to compare a stock's market value to its book value. Book value is simply total assets minus intangible assets and liabilities.

The P/B ratio of the fund is calculated as the weighted average of the P/B ratios of all the stocks in the fund's portfolio. Stocks with negative P/B ratios are excluded from this calculation.

IOPV, or Indicative Optimized Portfolio Value: A calculation disseminated by the stock exchange that approximates the Fund's NAV every 15 seconds throughout the trading day.
